Conversion to Operational Guidelines

- Streamlined, purpose-driven governance model with sharper scope
- Increased emphasis on the Network's core operating mechanisms:
 - Expected strategic outcomes
 - Workflow execution pathways
 - Defined participation expectations and accountability for membership

Refinement of expected strategic outcomes

Introduced a preamble to clearly articulate the Network's intended strategic outcomes:

1. Agenda for integrated economics statistics
2. Continuous improvement
3. User-driven frontier issues

and their alignment with overarching objectives.

Membership roles and responsibilities

Shift from membership information to clear expectations and accountabilities

- Enable participation from non-member experts
- Require active, high-value engagement from members
- Introduce activity-based membership review
- Clarify co-chairs' NSOs support for secretariat functions
- Formalize operating model
